How is the program set up?

We introduce many of the *California theatre standards* through activities then apply those standards in a showcase where every student will have plenty of stage time. Our showcases are familiar works that are abridged versions of recognizable, family shows. They have been adapted to maximize ensemble numbers. Each student receives a CYT@school t-shirt to wear, along with a costume piece that is provided. We use no sets and props are minimal. Our emphasis is on the *experience* of learning about performing and then guiding the students to do their best.

We invite children, grades 1 – 8; please let us know if your child has needs that we should be aware of.

Please note: Classes will be meeting once a week. The last class will be on May 24 followed by a dress rehearsal with the performance at 6:00. *(Food will be coordinated for the students before their showcase.)*
